Traffic Service Requests

A Traffic Service Request deals with persistent traffic violation(s) that are noted by the public in a specific area and that can be expected to reoccur when a responding Officer attends to the complaint. Concerns may include:

- Speeding
- School or Playground Zones
- Trucks / Commercial Vehicles
- Pedestrian & Intersection Safety Issues
- Illegal Turns

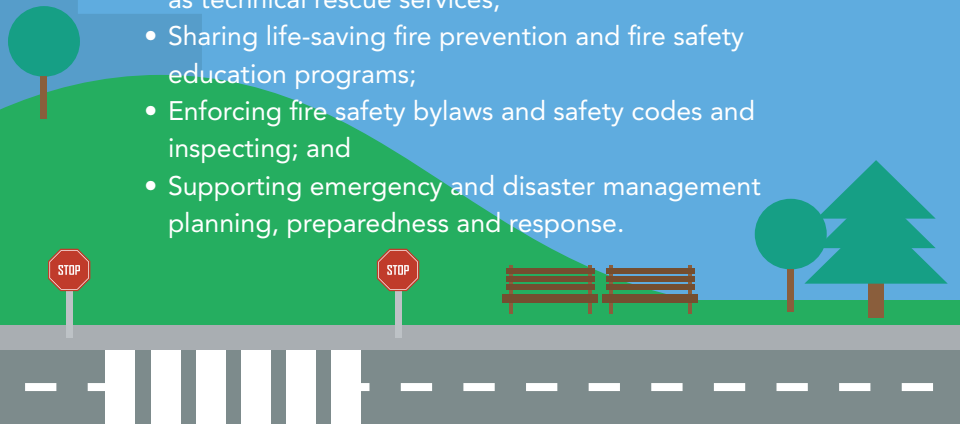




Calgary Fire Department (CFD)

The CFD's mission is to serve the community through excellence in fire prevention, education, protection and safety. The CFD is dedicated to the health, safety and vitality of Calgarians, and delivers services through an integrated program of emergency fire and medical response, fire prevention, education and enforcement. CFD also works with other agencies to support emergency and disaster management planning, preparedness and response. With 4 platoons of firefighters located in 39 fire stations across Calgary, the CFD provides a range of emergency and non-emergency services which include:

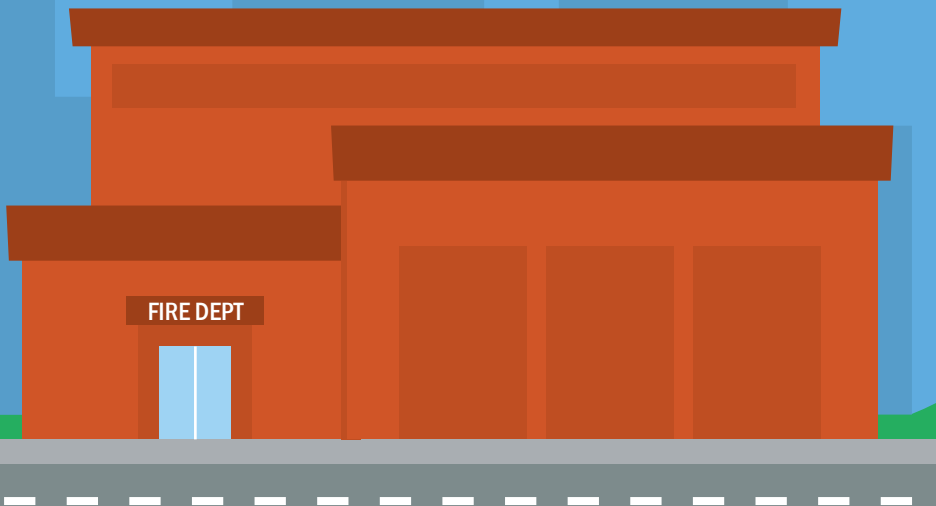
- Delivering emergency fire and medical response as well as technical rescue services;
- Sharing life-saving fire prevention and fire safety education programs;
- Enforcing fire safety bylaws and safety codes and inspecting; and
- Supporting emergency and disaster management planning, preparedness and response.



Evergreen Fire Station 37 (2511 Eversyde Avenue SW)

Station 37 provides emergency response service for the communities of Ward 13 and is a permanent three-bay facility which opened in December 2013.

Calgary Emergency Management Agency (CEMA)

Whether it is floods, fires, or influenza, emergencies can happen anytime, anywhere. It's not always possible to avoid these emergencies, but you can be prepared. Be equipped to support yourself and your family for up to three days after an emergency. Having an emergency plan and a 72-hour kit will help you manage until emergency responders can reach you and allows them to focus their efforts on those in immediate danger.
