- Retrofitting or removing above ground natural gas infrastructure.
- Installing new high-pressure natural gas lines primarily alongside ring roads (Transportation/Utility Corridors) surrounding Edmonton and Calgary.

What You Can Expect

During construction, there may be lane closures or reduced accessibility to roads, alleys or pathways.

While in your neighbourhood, our work will consist of digging in municipal roadways or boulevards. This work will not take place on private property. You may also experience increased traffic, construction noise and detours. To help ensure public safety, excavations open and accessible to the public will be fenced or supervised. Please be aware of hazards and avoid excavation sites.

- 🔥 Work areas will be restored to the same condition as they were before the start of the project.
- 🔥 The installation of the new gas lines will employ all the latest technologies available and will meet or exceed building and construction standards to ensure continued safe and reliable natural gas service.
