Relocation of Water Main at Fish Creek Boulevard S.W.

Activity and Location: As construction work commences for the Southwest Calgary Ring Road (SWCRR), KGL Constructors will be relocating a water main near the intersection of 37 Street S.W., 146 Avenue and Fish Creek Boulevard S.W.

Activity at the site is expected to include:

- Excavation for the new water main
- Installation of the new water main
- Equipment operating in the area
- Equipment entering and exiting roadways
- An increase in noise during working hours

Construction to excavate and install the new water main near the community of Evergreen will continue throughout May, then be intermittent as work moves further west. Activity will then return to the area in mid to late June to complete the connection to existing infrastructure. The decommissioned water main section west of the intersection will be removed during earthworks for the SWCRR.

Scheduled Completion Date: July 8, 2017

Hours of Work: Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
